# STAFF'S THIRD STATUS REPORT PURSUANT TO THE COMMISSION'S SEPTEMBER 8, 2025, ORDER SETTING PREHEARING CONFERENCE AND RELATED DUTIES

The Utility Division Staff ("Staff") of the New Mexico Public Regulation Commission ("Commission", "NMPRC" or "PRC") hereby submits Staff's Third Status Report Pursuant to the Commission's September 8, 2025, Order Setting Prehearing Conference and Related Duties, and would show the Commission as follows:

The September 8, 2025, Order specified in pertinent part that:

Staff shall file with the Commission a weekly report on the Thursday following each status conference providing updates on the current status of water service, the outlook for its restoration, developments with potential partners to restore service, and any other matters they believe to be of importance to this proceeding.

See September 8, 2025, Order at page 2, decretal paragraph D.

#### **Current Status of Water Service**

The water service remains below acceptable performance standards. The sole well used to provide water to the system continues to produce at diminished capacity – currently at approximately 4 to 5 gallons per minute versus the levels enjoyed historically. Service to the tap remains pressure-deficient and time-limited in availability to allow for the storage tank to attain and retain appropriate levels. During the period September 21<sup>st</sup> through September 27<sup>th</sup> one resident reports the following water system performance stats:

This comes to a total of 22 hours of water availability during the specified time-period.

### The Outlook for Restoration of Water Service

EMWT Regional Water Association is proceeding with its engineering due diligence review of the Melody Ranch system along with its effort, in conjunction with NMED subject matter experts, to address the economic (funding) component via the Drinking Water State Revolving Fund ("DWSRF") pre-application process. Melody Ranch is understood to be facilitating this process via the provision of documents and information that will inform EMWT's analysis and due diligence.

In furtherance of this effort, Melody Ranch executed and circulated a Letter of Intent for Melody Ranch Water Co., LLC to engage in a Transfer of Assets to EMWT Regional Water Association and Abandonment of the utility approved by the NM Public Regulation Commission.

The Letter of Intent provides in significant part:

This letter of intent sets forth the preliminary, non-binding proposal for Melody Ranch to transfer, at no cost, all of its assets to EMWT, which include, but are not limited to, the water rights, infrastructure, equipment, customer information, documents of system, and goodwill upon approval of an Abandonment of the water

utility by the NM PRC. Melody Ranch is prepared to enter into a binding transfer agreement as soon as EMWT is ready.

See The Legal Division's October 2, 2025, Notice of Filing Regarding Melody Ranch Letter of

Intent to EMWT, September 24, 2025, Letter of Intent attached thereto. The Letter of Intent

memorializes a significant commitment on the part of Melody Ranch to facilitate restoration of

water service via its cooperation with EMWT and others. Staff continues to monitor these efforts

and stands ready to assist as needed in the realization of the shared goal of water service restoration.

**Developments with Potential Partners to Restore Service** 

Simultaneous to the matters touched on above, Staff is communicating with other potential

partners to try and determine and structure how water service as it currently exists might be

enhanced in the interim. Discussions with Torrance County and others in state government are

being pursued with particular attention dedicated to the means of prospectively funding and

technically/legally achieving enhancement of water service during the interim period leading up

to the ultimate restoration of water service. Staff will continue to pursue this line of inquiry and

collaboration towards structuring and accommodating a better level of water service during this

interim period.

**Conclusion (for the Moment)** 

Melody Ranch's *Letter of Intent* and cooperation with EMWT are encouraging. Efforts and

evaluations regarding the economic and technical requirements of what is contemplated towards

the ultimate restoration of water service remain underway. Staff remains in the loop and will

otherwise continue to inquire of and interact with Melody Ranch, EMWT, and NMED towards

supporting and realizing these objectives. Staff is also pursuing possible paths towards enhancing

water service in the interim that will hopefully improve on the current status of water service.
