#### SUPPLEMENTAL STATUS REPORT

The Utility Division Staff ("Staff") of the New Mexico Public Regulation Commission (the "Commission") provides this supplemental status report in response to the December 9, 2025, Order Setting Status Conference Schedule and Report Deadlines. Staff respectfully submits the following:

- The hearing examiner's December 9, 2025, order directed Staff to file a report providing (1) the historical averages of water usage at Melody Ranch for October and November, the actual water usage for October and November 2025, and an estimated timeline of how long the emergency funds provided by the state will last, taking into account both past and current monthly usage rates.
- On December 12, 2025, Staff filed a partial response to the aforementioned order of the (2) hearing examiner, providing all but the estimated timeline of how long the emergency funds provided by the state will last. Since that time, Staff has obtained the data from Melody Ranch necessary to provide an estimate. Staff has also obtained additional information from its state agency partners as to the current status of the state's funds.<sup>2</sup>
- Based on past and current monthly usage rates, as well as the cost to haul water and Melody (3) Ranch's current well production, Staff estimates that the remaining state funds should be sufficient

for well over another year of water hauling. This assumes, however, that there is no further

interruption of the water produced by Melody Ranch's existing well. This estimate is also subject

to other potential variables, most notably the water conservation practices of Melody Ranch

customers. Staff's calculations towards this estimate are shown on the spreadsheet attached as

Exhibit A.<sup>3</sup>

(4) In addition to these calculations, Staff has also obtained additional information from its

state agency partners as to the status of the state's funds. Of the \$250,000 made available to assist

Melody Ranch, the state has expended approximately \$20,047.91. The highest cost week to date

was \$3404.36 (the week of December 1). At this rate, Staff has been informed that the state could

fund approximately 67 additional weeks (after December 12, 2025) of water hauling. This

estimate, however, again is subject to other variables.

To recap the discussion at the status conference on December 16, 2025, the water hauling

regime remains fully operational, and it appears that water is being provided to Melody Ranch

customers without interruption at this time.
