



INITIAL NOTICE OF OPEN MEETING: REGULAR OPEN MEETING

The New Mexico Public Regulation Commission (“PRC”) gives notice of its **Open Meeting: Regular Open Meeting** scheduled for **Thursday, September 21, 2023 at 10:00 a.m.**

This will be a hybrid meeting held in person and via Zoom. The public is welcome to attend the meeting in person at the Bokum Building located at 142 W. Palace Ave., Santa Fe, NM 87501. The public may also view the meeting remotely via a livestream on YouTube. If the meeting is disrupted due to technical difficulties it will be reconvened the same day; if this occurs, please check this website for info and instructions on how and when to rejoin.

Individuals wishing to make public comment at this meeting may do so in person at the Bokum Building, via the Zoom app or by telephone. It is advisable to sign up for public comment as early as possible and no later than two hours before the start of the Open Meeting; individuals who do not sign up will not be allowed to make comment. Any person who makes derogatory or otherwise inappropriate statements or who shares inappropriate messages or videos will be immediately removed from the meeting.

The order of the agenda items may be revised at the open meeting. The Commission may go into Executive Session to discuss these items pursuant to NMSA 1978 § 10-15-1H(3) & (7) Deliberations by a public body in connection with an administrative adjudicatory proceeding.

The Commission may request that any party answer clarifying questions or provide oral argument with respect to any matter listed on the agenda. If the Commission makes such a request, any party present at the meeting shall have an equal opportunity to respond to such questions or argument. In the event a party whose case is on the agenda chooses not to appear, the absence of that party shall not cause such discussion or argument to become ex-parte communication.
